Is online teaching new to you? Don't know where to start? We'll begin with the simplest interactive course: a "welcome to the class" section with a reading and one forum. We'll talk about technology: how settings change the forum interface; but we'll also discuss teaching technique: how to present introductory material to students who may have a wide range of experience and expectations. Over the 10 weeks, we'll cover: introducing the moodle environment; chats; forums; choices and surveys; lessons; assignments; databases; wikis; quizzes; You will have your own lesson space to explore all these tools and will be expected to look at each other's work and react to it. Time commitment: 2 or more hours per week. By November we should all be ready to design and offer creative Moodle courses of our own.



Shearman Taber and Sarah Spencer, members of Beacon Hill Friends Meeting, combine a long-time interest in learning as a spiritual practice with a willingness to explore new technologies and see whether they can serve Quaker needs.
