"Deep within us all there is ... a holy place..., a Divine Center, a speaking voice..." wrote Thomas Kelly. If we understand this "holy place " it will deepen our unity as a religious society, and move us forward in our quest for Justice .

In *A Testament of Devotion*, Thomas Kelly explores five themes:

- The Light Within,
- Holy Obedience,
- The Blessed Community,
- The Eternal Now and Social Concern,
- The Simplification of Life

Over five weeks we will consider how these themes relate to our life and practice as Quakers. There will be a weekly Foundation Lecture, Open Discussion, and perhaps some Internet reflections. Participants will read from *A Testament of Devotion* during the

course. Related resource material will be provided by the instructor.

**Greg Williams** is a member of New Bedford Friends Meeting and has worked for many years in urban ministry and peace education. He was on AFSC staff from 1975 - 84 in southeast Massachusetts. For many years in Boston—and recently in New Bedford—he has actively initiated outreach to communities of color. Greg is also a voracious and thoughtful Quaker reader who generously shares the fruits of that study. Like his course last winter on Lucretia Mott and Caroline Stephen, this promises to be a rich exploration of a Quaker classic.
